

Achievement of Saran District Police for the last six months

1) Chapra Town P.S. Case No.-87/15, dt-07.04.2015, u/s 363/364A IPC.

The case has been instituted on the basis of the written complaint of Arvind Pandey, S/o Sarvanand Pandey, R/o Mohalla-Purvi Salempur, behind Mosque, Mauna-Sardha Road for the kidnapping of his 3 and ½ years old son Aditya Pandey against the unknown accused persons and demand for ransom of Rs. 15,00,000/- by Mobile No.-9835096776.

As soon as the case was reported the Police team lead by Superintendent of Police, Saran started action by leaps and bound and immediately an special team was constituted comprising Sh. Raj Kumar Karn, SDPO, Sadar, 2-Sh. Satyendra Kumar Singh, Police Inspector, Sadar Circle, 3-Om Prakash, SHO Town, 4-Rana Prasad, S.I. Town P.S., 5-Jai Narayan Ram, S.I. Town P.S., 6-Raghunath Prasad, SHO Garkha, 7-S.I.Amarjeet Kumar, Technical Cell, 8-ASI Ram Kumar Singh, Confidential Reader, 9-Cons/690 Bhanu Pratap Dwivedi and 10-Cons/215, Anjani Kumar. On the basis of technical input, human intelligence, CDR Analysis of Mobile No.-9835096776 and further investigation in this case one Vikash Kumar Tiwari, S/o Ashok Tiwari who was a tenant in the house of Arvind Pandey came in the light as a conspirator of the plot for kidnapping for ransom and he was taken in police custody for enquiry. During his interrogation Vikash Kumar Tiwari accepted his indulgence in the case narrated the story as: Vikash Kumar Tiwari, being the tenant in the house of Arvind Pandey, he was well known to the status of house owner and thought that after kidnapping of the child he can get enough cash and with this intent he plotted the conspiracy of kidnapping with his other friends namely 1-Satish Kumar Tiwari @ Randhir Kumar @ Randha, S/o Sawaliya Tiwari, 2-Amit Kumar Tiwari, S/o Dharmnath Tiwari, 3-Javed Alam, S/o Samsul Hoda, 4-Mithilesh Kumar Prasad, S/o Kanhaiya Prasad all R/o Kolhua Karnpur, P.S.-Marhaura, Dist-Saran. As per their plan Javed Alam was called by Vikash Tiwari at his residence at Salempur Chapra on 07.04.2015 and He handed over the child named Aditya Pandey to Javed Alam taking the benefit of absence of Arvind Pandey from home and thereafter the child was taken by Javed to Karnpura where he was kept in the vacant house (closed for more 10 years) of Sanjay Baitha, S/o Dahari Baitha, Vill-Karnpura, Marhaura in the guarding of - Satish Kumar Tiwari @ Randhir Kumar @

Randha, Amit Kumar Tiwari and Mithilesh Kumar Prasad. Raids were conducted as per the indications of Vikash Kumar Tiwari and the kidnapped child Aditya Pandey was recovered from the staid place followed by the arrest of Satish Kumar Tiwari @ Randhir Kumar @ Randha, Amit Kumar Tiwari, Mithilesh Kumar Prasad and Javed Alam. Charge Sheet vide CS No.-56/15, dt-18.04.2015 was submitted against all the above accused persons. **The most important thing is that the case has been detected within 04 hours of its reporting with the recovery of kidnapped victim Aditya Pandey followed by the arrest of all of the accused persons.**

During the further course of investigation it was found that demand of Rs. 15,00,000/- was also made by the Mobile No.-8374908207. During the tracing of this mobile it was found that the mobile was being utilized in Adhra Pradesh by Amresh Kumar Tiwari who was the resident of Vill-Tejpurwa, P.S.-Marhaura, Dist-Saran and for his arrest a team comprising two sub-inspectors and one constable was sent to Andhra Pradesh by taking proper order of the DIG, Saran Range, Chapra from where Amresh Kumar Tiwari was arrested and Supplementary Charge Sheet vide CS No.-89/15, dt-06.08.2015 was submitted against him.

2) Manjhi P.S. Case No.-228/2015, dt-21.07.2015, u/s 395 IPC.

An incident of dacoity occurred in the night of 20/21.11.2015 during 06.00 p.m.-07.00 p.m. in the house of Yogendra Sah, S/o Sohan Sah and his cousin Bhikhari Sah, S/o Mohan Sah in which dacoits took all the family members in their possessions and by threatening them with gun and knives they looted the valuables. Regarding the incident Manjhi P.S. Case No.-228/15, dt-21.07.2015, u/s 395 IPC was instituted.

For detection of the case, the Superintendent of Police, Saran constituted a team comprising SDPO, Sadar, Police officers and constables and the team members acted with their 100 percent effort. By using their wit, human intelligence and technical input they came to know the exact location of the crime perpetrators and raids were conducted by the team in a pre-planned way as a result of which looted materials 1-Mobile Set-01, 2- Sarees (09 pairs), 3-Payal (05 pairs) and 4-Nathiya-01 were recovered followed by the arrest of 1-Gopal Ram, S/o Chandeshwar Ram, Vill-Dalpatpur, P.S.-Maharajganj, Dist-Siwan, 2-Santosh Kumar Ram, S/o Raj Kumar Ram, Vill-Mehandiganj, P.S.-Manjhi, Dist-Saran, 3-Anuj Kumar @ Prasunn Kumar Upadhyaya, S/o Sant Sharan Upadhyaya, Vill-Rampur, P.S.-Rasulpur, at present Bairiya, Dist-Ballia (U.P.), 4-Ravindra Singh @ Toni, S/o Raghunath Singh, Vill-Sirisiya, P.S.-Rivilganj, Dist-Saran along with 02 country made gun, 05 live cartridges of .315 bore. All of the arrested accused persons were forwarded to judicial custody. Detection of this case proved very fruitful in improving the image of police in the public and assuring the mass their security.

3) Sonapur P.S. Case No.-438/15, dt-11.11.2015, u/s 395/397 IPC.

The case has been instituted on the basis of the Fardbyan of Kanti Devi, W/o Late Vijay Sah, Vill-Bharpura NayaTola, P.S.-Sonapur, Dist-Saran against 5-6 unknown criminals for the loot of Rs. 40,000/-, jewellery of worth Rs. 1,50,000/- and other household valuables being committed in the night of 10/11.11.2015.

By the stern and sincere action of the police the case has been detected with arresting of Non FIR accused 1-Umesh Das and 2-Lalu Sahani who accepted their indulgence in the crime.

During Investigation and Supervision of the case it has been true under sections 395/397 IPC against Non FIR accused persons namely 1-Lalu Sahani, S/o Sanichar Sahani, Vill-Nakhas Chowk, 2-Umesh Das, S/o Baleshwar Das, Vill-Konharaghat, 3-Kanhaiya Thakur, S/o Ajya Thakur, Vill-Bagmali, all P.S.-Town, Dist-Hajipur and 4-Dishu Rai, S/o Vijay Rai, 5-Arun Rai, S/o Lalan Rai both R/o Vill-Baburbani, 6-Shanker Pasi, S/o Devki Pasi, Vill-Golabazar of P.S. Sonapur, Dist-Saran.

Among the above named accused persons Lalu Sahani, Umesh Das and Kanhaiya Thakur have been arrested in connection with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No.- 825/15 and forwarded to judicial custody who have to be remanded in the case.

4) Ekma P.S. Case No.-160/15, dt-23.08.2015, u/s 302/34 IPC & 27 Arms Act.

The case has been instituted on the basis of the written complaint of Madan Mahaot, S/o Bijli Mahato, Vill-Parsa Garh Bazar, P.S.-Ekma, Dist-Saran against FIR named accused 1-Veer Bikram Vikash Singh @ Bitu Singh, S/o Bhupendra Singh, 2-Chandan Singh, both R/o Parsagarh, P.S.-Ekma, Dist-Saran for the murder of son of the informant.

During the course of investigation CDR Analysis of the concerned persons was performed with edge and on the basis of the sharp techniques the case was detected. Investigation and supervision of the case indicated it to be true against Non FIR accused 1-Lalan Prasad, S/o Chandeshwar Prasad, Vill-Parsagarh, P.S.-Ekma, Dist-Saran and 2-Ravindra Sharma @ Buchchan Sharma, S/o Jagarnath Sharma, Vill-Rith, P.S.-Ekma, Dist-Saran and one unknown and sufficient evidence for Charge Sheet was found. Non FIR accused Lalan Prasad was arrested who during his confessional statement narrated the name of Anil Rastogi, S/o Ramayan Rastogi, Vill-Parsagarh, P.S.-Ekma, Dist-Saran and in this way, accusation against the named FIR accused 1-Veer Bikram Vikash Singh @ Bitu Singh and 2-Chandan Singh was found false. Arrested accused person Lalan Prasad was sent to judicial custody and efforts are being made to arrest the rest of the accused persons. Detection of this case proved very fruitful in improving the image of police in the public and assuring the mass that their false accusation will not lead them to the jail.

- 5) **Maker P.S. Case No.-120/15, dt-23.11.2015, u/s 392 IPC.**
- 6) **Taraiya P.S. Case No.-159/15, dt-06.12.2015, u/s 392 IPC.**
- 7) **Masharak P.S. Case No.-317/15, dt-05.11.2015, u/s 392 IPC.**

On the basis of the secret information that some criminals are to be gathered at Sutihar Bank under Derni P.S. jurisdictions, the Superintendent of Police, Saran directed SHOs of Derni and Parsa P.S. to reach the place and render a thorough search. After getting the directions the police team started actions without delay and deep search was started in the areas of possible hideouts of the criminals. During the thorough search it came to light that 5-6 criminals with 03 bykes have been assembled at Sutihar Devi Asthan with having target at State Bank of India, Sutihar Branch. Acting immediately, the Police team reached the spot from where the criminal started to run away after seeing the police team but in the mean time police team managed to arrest two persons who unveiled their recognition as following:

- 1- Lal Babu Miyan, S/o Abbas Miyan, Vill-Harpur Parsa,
- 2- Sandeep Kumar, S/o Anil Ojha @ Bholu Ojha @ Bholu Kunwar, Vill-Parsa Mathura, both R/o P.S.-Parsa, Dist-Saran.

Two loaded country made gun (Deshi Katta), 03 live cartridges and looted Rs. 4,500/- were recovered from their possession. During their interrogation they stated that they were accompanied with 1-Balwant Singh, S/o Kaushal Singh @ Madan Singh, 2-Satyendra Rai @ Rai Jee, both R/o Vill-Sarangpur, P.S.-Panapur, Dist-Saran, 3-Baidyanath Singh @ Manoranjan Kumar Singh, S/o Ramayan Singh, Vill-Baidapur, P.S.-Marhaura, Dist-Saran, 4-Krishna Rai, S/o Tona Rai, Vill-Balui, P.S.-Marhaura, Dist-Saran, 5-Gopi Kumar @ Rupesh Kumar, S/o Yamuna Singh, Vill-Bhagwanpur, P.S. Parsa, Dist-Saran. All them had planned to loot the cash van but any how they could not succeed and after that they assembled at Katsa, where they again planned to loot State Bank of India, Sutihar Branch under the Derni P.S. jurisdictions and for the same they gathered at Sutihar Devi Asthan from where they have been arrested.

During further enquiry they confessed that the incidents of loot occurred recently in the district in the jurisdictions of Maker, Taraiya and Masharak P.S. have been committed by them, descriptions of which are as follows:

- 1- The incident of loot of Rs. 1,80,000/- and one Glamour Motor cycle of the Petrol Pump under Maker P.S. area has been committed by them regarding

which Maker P.S. Case No.-120/15, dt23.11.2015, u/s 392 IPC has been instituted. On the basis of their indications Police teams of Maker/Derni/Parsa/Panapur/Ishuapur/Bheldi/Taraiya/Masharak P.S. conducted raids separately and the looted Motor Cycle was recovered from the house of Balwant Singh who was later arrested.

- 2- The incident of loot of Rs. 2,400/- and one Motor Cycle from a person in Masharak-Taraiya road falling under the jurisdictions of Taraiya P.S. was committed by them regarding which Taraiya P.S. Case No.-159/2015, dt-06.12.2015, u/s 392 IPC has been instituted. On the basis of their indications looted Motor Cycle was recovered from the house of one Sonu Kumar, S/o Tufani Rai, R/o Kajipur, P.S.-Doriganj who was later arrested. During the interrogation of Sonu Kumar it came to light that the concerned byke has been bought by Sonu from Sandeep Kumar, S/o Anil Ojha @ Bholu Kunwar by paying an amount of Rs. 7,500/-.
- 3- The incident of loot of one motor cycle, mobile, purse, ID Card and other documents from a person in Masharak-Dumarshan road falling under the jurisdictions of Masharak P.S. area has been committed by them regarding which Masharak P.S. Case No.-317/2015, dt-05.11.2015, u/s 392 IPC has been instituted. On the basis of their indications looted ID Card and SIM card used in the looted Mobile were recovered.
